The petition of the Subscribers, Inhabitants of
the Plantation of Smithfield, ^(so called) in the County
of Lincoln Humbly Sheweth:

that your petitioners having taken into consid-
eration the many Disadvantages which we
Labour under in this Plantation on the account
of our not being Incorporated: we cannot have
any Roads laid out Legally: nor Schooling for
our Children and many other Privileges we
are deprived off in this our Situation: We
therefore pray that this Honorable Court would
Incorporate this Certain tract of Land Bounded
as follows Beginning at the Northeast Corner of the
town of Bowdoin, thence Running westerly on its Bound-

Line six miles, thence ^{about} running north two
Degrees, West, ^{about} four miles, till it strikes Monmouth
South Line thence running Easterly on said Mon-
mouth ^{South Line about and half} one mile till it strikes the Corner
Bound ^{thence} thence Running Northerly on Monmouth
East Line six miles till it strikes Wintrip ^{on Wintrip South Line}

South Line: thence Running Easterly ^{to Coburns South line, from there East South East to Hallowell, thence} till it strikes Poteston West Line thence

Running Southerly on said Poteston west Line
over Bowdoin ^{from} west line ^{about} ten miles till it strikes
the first mentioned Bound ^{and there is included in the above bound upwards of one hundred families}

and if this petition be agreeable to this
Honorable Court we pray that you would
Incorporate ^{the} a Cove Bounded tract of Land into
